Chairman's speech



Vietnam has been a country haunted by various dumping activities for the past few years due to the nature of its trade policy and the free trade agreements signed by Vietnam and other main trading partners in the world. To support Vietnam steel business and protect Vietnam from the unreasonable dumping actions, CSVC has been standing out and devoting itself in the CG antidumping investigation since last year (2014) at its cost. With the support of domestic CG makers, Vietnam Steel Association (VSA) and Vietnam Competition Authority (VCA), CSVC is heading completion of the filing stage.

If CSVC wins this case, we will not only curb the low quality CG steel products imported from China but also create a fair competitive steel market.

In this time, we are getting into a brand-new stage after two years operation. On September 23rd, 2015, we achieved shipment volume of **one million tons for finished products**. This is a very important milestone in the Company's business development. Without all the employees' efforts, the Company cannot achieve this target. We strongly believe that once the economy gets better, we will be able to obtain more orders, realize higher productivity and earn the greatest interest for CSVC.

Up to October 1st, 2015, CSVC hasn't had any working day lost in occupational accidents for 409 days. This is an encouraging result for our effective safety management system to ensure the safety and health of all CSVC members.

Why did you choose CSVC?

Hi, this is Nguyen Phuong Bac, 33 years old, Section Manager of Utilities-P8. My main job is assisting GM to manage and supervise utilities supply such as potable water, natural gas, LPG station and

industrial gas (N2 and H2), CA, IW, DMW, steam supply and waste water treatment system.

Through some my Taiwanese friends, I knew CSVC is a large company invested by two leading steel corporations from Taiwan and Japan (CSC and NSSMC). Realizing this is a good chance to learn professional skill, with great potential to grow up by working with foreign dispatchers; I decided to apply the job and started working from Sep 1st, 2010.

Thanks to the enthusiastic supports from superiors, P8 overcame many difficulties at the construction stage. It took a very long time to negotiate with electrical power, water and natural gas suppliers to reach the agreement and to sign the purchase contract. CSVC got electrical power supply on Dec 23rd, 2012, potable water supply on Dec 25th, 2012 and the natural gas supply, the most difficult one to get, on Mar 12th, 2013. For me, it was very impressive to get the approval of suppliers, finish the construction work and get ready to supply all utilities to the production lines on time.

At present, CSVC's production turns to be more and more stable, productivity is increasing and quality is improving. P8's goal is providing utilities to all production lines stably and continuously. I and all P8's members always follow the motto "always safety-quality-efficiency and cost-down ". Protect your Throat



The change in weather is triggering respiratory problems for many people. To avoid getting sore throat, you should apply some simple ways to protect your throat as below:

1. Before brushing your teeth, dip your brush into the warm salt water to remove bacteria.
2. Mix 3-4gr of fresh ginger juice with 5ml of honey and drink it every morning, after brushing.
3. Drink ½ cup of hot water, mixed with 5gr salt and ½ spoonful of turmeric every night.
4. Rinse your mouth with warm salt water every morning & evening after brushing! This habit helps clean your throat and mouth, as well as killing all bacteria.
5. Chew a small piece of palm sugar to remove dust and other irritants in the throat and bronchial tubes due to the air pollution.
