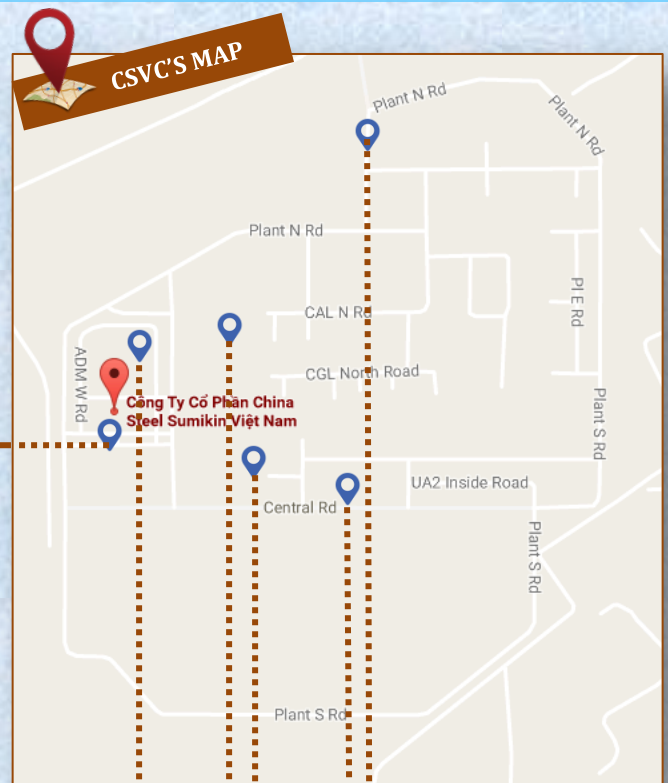

Main tasks of GDO

Administrative works

1. Arrange and confirm work schedule, meetings as well as business trips for Board of Directors; organize and prepare necessary documents for internal meetings, Board of Management meetings and General Shareholders' meetings.
2. Update economic - political - social information which may have some impact on the production & trading operation of the Company; collect necessary information as requested by the Board of Directors.

4. Receive guests coming to CSVN: arrange how to welcome and see off guests, make vehicle arrangements, dining arrangements (booking restaurants or corporate special meals), prepare presentation files, Company introduction DVD and other necessary stuffs.

5. Establish and maintain relationship with Vietnam Government Agencies as well as Taiwanese and Japanese enterprises.
6. Collect ideas and feedbacks from employees, then send to relevant departments for suitable solutions and reply.
7. Carry out other tasks as requested by the Board of Directors.

Legal works

1. Review, translate and provide legal advice for legitimate term and condition of all contracts, business licenses and other legal documents
2. Prepare legal documents for establishing, registering and changing Company's regulation, representative office, acquisition, divestitures, merge, license and other legal operational procedures.
3. Daily check Vietnamese Government amended regulations and newly promulgated regulations, report to the Board of Directors then send to all relevant Departments to follow.

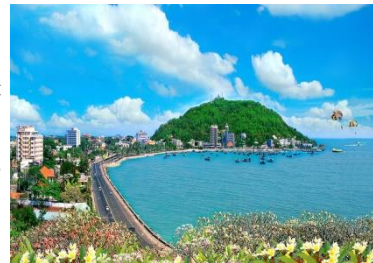
Splendid Hoi An

Vung Tau – The New Rising

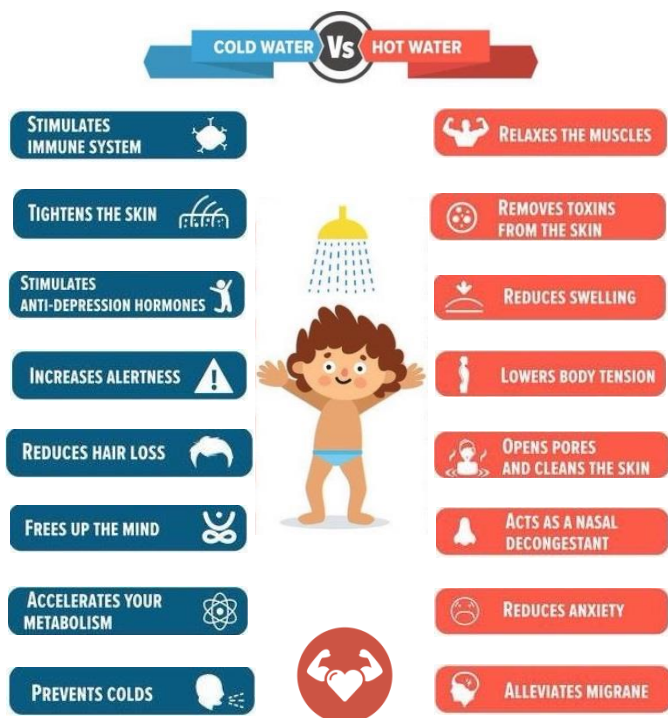
